

WITHDRAWAL FROM STUDY ABROAD POLICY DETAILS

If a student withdraws from a study abroad program and *re-enrolls at Holy Cross* the same semester:

- The student forfeits their flight credit
- Will get charged for HC fees and any unrecoverable charges that the college has incurred while abroad will be the responsibility of the student including but not limited to host institution tuition, host room/board, orientation fees, cultural activities.
- No guarantee of classes at HC
- No guarantee of on-campus housing
- Possible conditions may be required to re-enroll
- If a student withdraws they will be ineligible to go abroad the following semester.

If a student withdraws from a study abroad program and *takes a leave of absence* from Holy Cross:

- The student is subject to HC Bursar's refund policy:

- Possible loss of a semester worth of credits
- Possible conditions may be required to re-enroll
